 \cdot Resolution supporting a request for the City of Ogdensburg allowing taxation of NYS owned properties within the city. 50% of the property in the city is owned by NYS and they

pay absolutely no taxes. They won't sell it. St. Lawrence County believes that if they don't sell it, they should be paying taxes on it.

• Passed a resolution for the chairman to sign a contract with the American Recovery Act Funds for purpose of broadband development and installation projects.

• MAT - Medical Assisted Treatments, sheriff brought a resolution to increase the 2023 budget for the cost of incarcerated individuals. \$150,000 was budgeted last year. 116 incarcerated individuals, out of the 116, 60 are participating in the program.

• Matt Denner – Director/Fire Coordinator for St. Lawrence County has been conducting a survey with all the fire departments in the county. There are a couple of apps for dispatching fire/rescue calls, they are Active 911 and I am Responding, with the I am responding app, responders can reply directly to dispatch right on their phones. St., Lawrence County will be paying for this app.

 \cdot Received an email from Cory and Heather Hayes, regarding a resource officer at the school. Needs to be directed to the school board.

• Discussion on new door at the Clifton Fine Community Center.

• Floor Cleaner – Floors in the Clifton Community Center are spotted and cannot be cleaned by just mopping. J. Lanphear will call to see if the company we had before will do them.

• Beach Sign Replacement – W. Griffin talked to J. Dragun about replacing the sign, he said he was waiting for approval. Approval granted.

 \cdot Air Conditioners for Clifton Community Center – Two air conditioners are old and insufficient. W. Griffin will look into this.

• The North Shore HUB in Cranberry Lake is asking for sponsors of 32x36 panels to be on display with historic images of the town. A motion to sponsor one of the panels for \$800.00 was made by J. Lanphear with a second by M. Zuhlsdorf, Ayes = 3, Noes = 1, Abstain = 1.
